What is S.T.O.P.! Tipline?



Accessible The main purpose of the S.T.O.P.! Tipline is to add a layer of accessibility between students and trusted school personnel through the use of online technology devices.



Available A student, parent or community member can submit information day or night to the S.T.O.P.! Tipline using the logo on the school district's website.



Affordable Kentucky Center for School Safety offers this tipline, training and support **FREE** of charge to Kentucky school districts.



Stats and Facts

Districts Kentucky Center for School Safety currently has 144 tipline partnerships. A total of 582 schools have access to the tipline.



Students 273,717 students have direct access to an online reporting/communication tool for their safety concerns.



Trainings Representatives from each district are required to attend a ½ day training. This year eight trainings have been held across the commonwealth with 126 attending.



Tech Support The KCSS Resource Center provides **FREE** technical assistance to tipline partners. This year working individually with each district during the state-wide email migration.
