# S.T.O.P.! TIPLINE



## What is S.T.O.P.! Tipline?



**Accessible** The main purpose of the S.T.O.P.! Tipline is to add a layer of accessibility between students and trusted school personnel through the use of online technology devices.



**Available** A student, parent or community member can submit information day or night to the S.T.O.P.! Tipline using the logo on the school district's website.



**Affordable** Kentucky Center for School Safety offers this tipline, training and support **FREE** of charge to Kentucky school districts.



## Stats and Facts

**Districts** Kentucky Center for School Safety currently has 152 tipline partnerships. A total of 625 schools have access to the tipline.



**Students** 293,555 students have direct access to an online reporting/communication tool for their safety concerns.



**Trainings** Representatives from each district are required to attend a ½ day training. This year eight trainings have been held across the commonwealth with 126 attending.



**Tech Support** The KCSS Resource Center provides **FREE** technical assistance to tipline partners. This year working individually with each district during the state-wide email migration.
