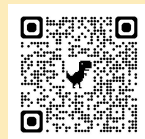
New Employees

- All new employees must be trained in emergency operations
- All new employees in 6-12 schools must be trained in suicide prevention
- All new employees must be trained and certified/classified evaluation
- Complete a sign-in sheet for all trainings

Suicide Prevention Training Update

- Per Senate Bill 2, the training requirements call for all staff members (grades 4-12) to receive this training. Additionally, all students (grades 6-12) shall receive this training before Sept. 15 and again by Jan. 15.
- Please make sure to document all staff members who received this training and any make-up training for those who weren't available for the initial training. Don't forget any new staff members who may be hired at any point during the school year.

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Suicide Prevention Training KRS 156.095

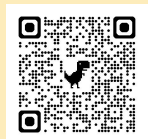

Toby Young State School Security Marshal

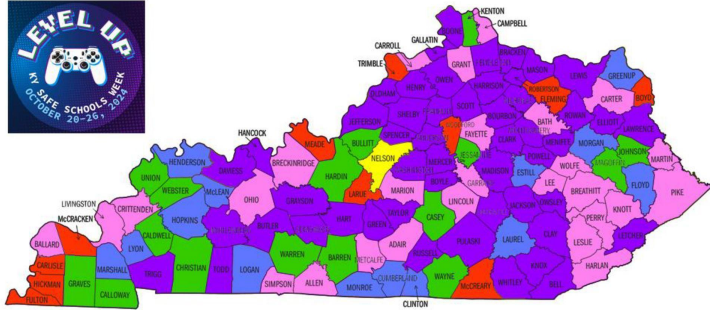

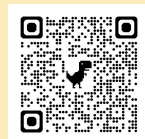

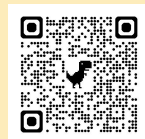
