



## Reporting is easy!

If you come across something upsetting, or if anyone asks you to do something inappropriate or that makes you uncomfortable, please report the Snap.

You can easily report inappropriate content to us right in the app! Just press and hold on the Snap, then tap the "Report Snap" button.

Safety is a shared responsibility.

Friends will only see the things that you send them directly or choose to post publicly to your Story.

Check your privacy settings to choose who can send you Snaps, or view your Stories and location on Snap Map.

Snapchat is also partnered with the Crisis Text Line to provide additional support and resources to Snapchatters in the US. Just text KIND to 741741 to chat with a live, trained crisis counselor at Crisis Text Line. This service is free and available 24/7!

# Law Enforcement Can Subpoena “IP Addresses”

On Social Media Apps, when users agree to the terms of service an account is formed and information is logged. One piece of this information is a user's **IP address**.

If a user is posting a “Threat” or dangerous material a law enforcement official can subpoena that information and the **IP address**.

The **IP address** is associated with a service provider, such as Verizon or ATT. Using the IP address the law enforcement officer can subpoena the service provider to supply name and address of the person who pays for that specific **IP address** for a cell service or internet service.

At that time, the law enforcement has all the information it takes to go to a specific home and both charge and apprehend the person responsible for the “threatening post.”

# TikTok



With Family Pairing, parents or guardians can link their TikTok accounts to their teens' to manage a variety of content, privacy, and well-being settings. These include features such as:

Setting a screen time limit, which is customizable by the day of the week.  
Customize your teen's For You feed using keywords. TikTok will filter out posts that contain the keywords that you choose by checking for them in the description of the post.

Customize your teen's comment controls or completely turn off comments.

Decide who can send messages or message requests to your teen.

View who your teen is following on TikTok, and who follows them, along with accounts they blocked.

Get an overview of your teen's privacy settings, such as their account visibility and who can comment on their posts.

You can support the community by reporting any video, comment, or account you believe violates our Community Guidelines.
