This letter of agreement will establish and outline the support of the School Resource Officer (SRO) Program with the [REDACTED]. The terms of the agreement between the [REDACTED] KY-ASAP Board and the [REDACTED] Independent School System to financially support the School Resource Officer Program are as follows:

1. DATES OF AGREEMENT- This agreement will cover the 2016-2017 school calendar which began on August 10, 2016 and is currently scheduled to end on May 23, 2017. The end date of this agreement will be extended to cover the entire school calendar if the school calendar is extended by vote of the [REDACTED] Board of Education.

2. OFFICERS- The [REDACTED] County KY-ASAP Board will provide support for one (1) law enforcement officer currently provided to the [REDACTED] Independent School System by the [REDACTED] Police Department.

3. EXPECTATIONS- The [REDACTED] County KY-ASAP Board's primary goal with the financial support of the SRO program is to allow for increased enforcement of local/state laws and school policies as it pertains to the reduction of substance (alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs) use among school-age youth. This may also include the officer providing educational sessions in classroom to provide students with greater knowledge and awareness of the dangers and consequences of using alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs. The [REDACTED] County KY-ASAP Board may ask for statistical information related to the enforcement of laws and policies to be used in program formation and/or grant writing. Any statistical information obtained will not be released to the media or general public without written consent from the appropriate administrator of the [REDACTED] Independent School System.

4. COMPENSATION- The [REDACTED] County KY-ASAP board shall pay the [REDACTED] Independent School System a maximum of \$4,000 per officer actively serving in the SRO program. Whereas the funding used to support the SRO program is provided by the Drug Free Communities grant, the [REDACTED] KY-ASAP Board will be permitted

to count a portion of the salaries of the School Resource Officers as "in-kind" match in order to assist with meeting the match requirements of the Drug Free Communities grant.

To indicate your acceptance of this agreement, please sign, date, and return the enclosed copy of this agreement. Upon receipt of the signed copy of this letter of agreement, The [REDACTED] county KY-ASAP Board will release payment of the funds described in this agreement and provide a signed copy of this letter of agreement for your records.
